Medals/trophies/other will be presented to all champions, finalists, and semi finalists</p> <p>In accordance with Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statue 5.3.6), all players participating in the finals of a tournament must attend the final ceremonies directly after the match or must follow the instructions given by the organizers regarding ceremony protocol.</p> <p>No equipment, including rackets and flags, are allowed to be brought onto the podium. Clothing worn during the ceremony must be in accordance with the BWF GCR. Wheelchair players are required to attend the ceremony in their wheelchairs.</p>
<p>Accreditation</p>	<p>Access to tournament venues and other services is provided through personalized and photographic accreditation. Everyone is required to fill up the accreditation form provided.</p> <p>The price of entry fee is chargeable to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes on each occasion, charged to the respective Member Association.</p> <p>The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation.</p> <p>The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.</p>

<p>COVID-19 Protocols</p>	<p><u>COVID-19 Government Regulations</u></p> <p>Colombian government has not any other additional requirements besides the pre-registration from (Check Mig) which must be completed online.</p>

However, the uses of face mask is mandatory at closed spaces like, restaurants, theaters, coliseums, shopping malls among others.

Measures like self-care are promoted by the local authorities but this is a personal responsibility.

COVID-19 Tournament Protocols

Since BWF have started the Phase 3, there is no longer required a mandatory bubble for tournament participants, as well pre-arrival Negative PCR results. However, considering that this Continental Championships will have players which are in a risk condition BPAC will request the following:

- Pre-arrival negative Covid result.
 - A participant must submit or present upon arrival, a Negative PCR results between the 72h at the time of the arrival or present a Negative Antigen result within 24h of the time of the arrival.
 - During the week, a control test will be delivered to a sample of the 30% of the participants including TOs and Coaches.
 - Control test should be borne by the participants itself
